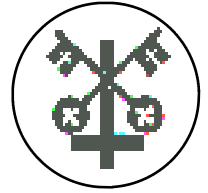

ST PETER'S BELLS

Thanks to the generosity of a number of donors, after some years of silence the two bells in the tower of St Peter's Church again sound out across Boxted. One bell (the tenor) has been recast and both bells rehung; modern technology enables the bells to be chimed electrically (and to chime the hours) but a team of ringers has been formed to ring them in the time-honoured way.

The successful completion of the project owes much to the efforts of many individuals. But special thanks are due to Alison Human, Churchwarden of St. Peter's at the time, who masterminded it. Without her enthusiasm and hard work the dream would not have become a reality.

Hugh Large, a Boxted resident, has produced an extensive (over 850 images) photographic record of the project, a selection of which he has reproduced in a very fine Commemorative Book. Copies are available from Hugh at £38 (contact him by email at hugh@hughlarge.com).

On Sunday 21 September (6 pm) the Bishop of Chelmsford, the Right Reverend John Gladwin, will come to St Peter's to celebrate the Eucharist and dedicate the bells. All parishioners are invited to join the celebrations.
