The recognised archivist for the civil parish of Boxted is Anne Newman, Stoneleigh, Cage Lane (Tel. 272351). She is ever keen to receive any papers or other material that would enhance the village archive. A recent particularly interesting approach has been by an American researching the life of Sir Richard Blackmore (c.1654-1729), Royal physician, who lived in retirement at Pond House (a memorial to Blackmore and his wife may be seen at St Peter's Church).
